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Success Factors



- The quality of learning depends on the depth of students' engagement in the learning process
- The skill and effort that teachers use to create learning experiences is the main determinant of the achieved quality of the learning environment
- Teachers have a lack of time and adequate technical support as well as training in pedagogical principles
